

## DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

Please note that GPS will NOT take you directly to this site!

**FROM ROUTE 80 EAST OR WEST - EXIT 27A to RT. 206 S.** Go 4 miles, turn **RIGHT** onto **BARTLEY RD.** just before the railroad overpass. Go approximately **1 MILE** to Top Dog Obedience School on your **RIGHT**.

**FROM ROUTE 287 - EXIT 22B to ROUTE 206 N.** Take Rt. 206 N through the town of **CHESTER** and cross the intersection of **RT. 206 & ROUTES 24/513**. Stay on **RT. 206** to the **2nd TRAFFIC LIGHT**, make **LEFT** onto **BARTLEY-CHESTER RD.** Cross over the railroad tracks, turn **RIGHT** then make an immediate **LEFT** to Top Dog Obedience School.

Make a **LEFT** out of the parking lot on **BARTLEY RD/CR-612** toward **FLANDERS BARTLEY RD.** Make the 1st **RIGHT** onto **FLANDERS BARTLEY RD.** and take the 1st **LEFT** onto **US-206**. Turn **RIGHT** onto **MAIN ST./CR-613/MAIN ST. FLANDERS**. Turn **SLIGHT LEFT** onto **NORTH RD./CR-619** (CR-619 is just past **MOUNTAIN AVE.**). Turn **LEFT** onto **HILLSIDE AVE. S/CR-619** and go approximately 2.6 miles and turn **SLIGHT RIGHT** onto **RT. 10 E.** Make a **U-TURN** at **CENTER GROVE RD.** onto **RT. 10 W** to 540 RT. 10.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

**EXTREME WEATHER CONDITIONS**, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightening, extreme heat must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to stop or cancel the trial before completion, no refund of entry fees will be made. If cancellation is decided before the event, every effort will be made to notify the exhibitors via the info provided on their entries. **JUMP HEIGHTS** must be listed in accordance with AKC rules. **ENTRIES WITHOUT JUMP HEIGHTS** will be judged at the end of the class, as well as transfers. Performances will be run in ascending order for both trials.

**THE TRIAL WILL BE OPEN** from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

**AS SPECIFIED IN CHAPTER 12, SECTION 4** of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

**DOGS MAY ARRIVE** any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.**

**JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS.** Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

**ALL DOGS PRESENT** must be held on a leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercise area. Exercise your dog in the designated potty area only; please clean up after your dog. **DO NOT let your dog potty in the landscaped areas around the building.**

**UNENTERED DOGS** will not be permitted in the buildings as space is limited. Thank you for respecting this.

**NO EX-PENS** are permitted on the premises. Please bring your own chairs. Crates and chairs will be placed in properly designated areas only. Please be considerate of other exhibitors needing crate space.

**FOOD CONCESSIONS** will not be for sale at this trial except for bottled water, so please bring your own food and beverages. There are a number of fast food restaurants and eateries close by the show site on Rt. 206.

**CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM** for time of judging.

**REFUND CHECKS** are void after 180 days and will NOT be re-issued.

**THE TRIAL COMMITTEE** will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this trial. **THE DOBERMAN PINSCHER CLUB OF THE TAPPAN ZEE AND TOP DOG OBEDIENCE SCHOOL WILL NOT BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ACCIDENT** that may occur to any person, animal, property or vehicle. The exhibitors shall hold the Trial Committee harmless and indemnify it against any legal proceeding arising from any accident.

**NO GASOLINE OR DIESEL GENERATORS** are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any building in which this dog show is conducted.

**NO OVERNIGHT CAMPING/RV** is permitted on this trial site.
